of the Fees Charged by the Commission for the Protection of Competition Under the Law on the Protection of Competition

Article 1. The Commission for the Protection of Competition shall charge the following fees:

	Fees (in BGL)
1. For authorisation under art. 13 of the Law	200
2. For authorisation under art. 15 (2) of the Law	50.
3. For requests to issue authorisations under art. 28 of the Law	500
4. For issuance of authorisations under art. 28 of the Law	500
5. For applications under art. 36, subsection 1, item 1 of the Law	50
6. For other requests under the Law	20
7. For verification of transcripts (copies) of documents	0, 5 for the first page and 0,25 for every other page
8. For verification of transcripts of decisions	1 for the first page and 0,5 for every other page
9. For issuance of statements from the register under art. 7 (2) (5) of the Law	1 for the first page and 0,5 for every other page

Article 2. (1) The fees under art. 1 (1), (2), (3), (5) and (6) shall be collected upon the submission of the application or request, whereas those under (4) shall be collected upon issuance of the authorisation.

(2) The fees under art. 1 (7), (8) and (9) shall be collected upon receiving the transcripts and statements.
